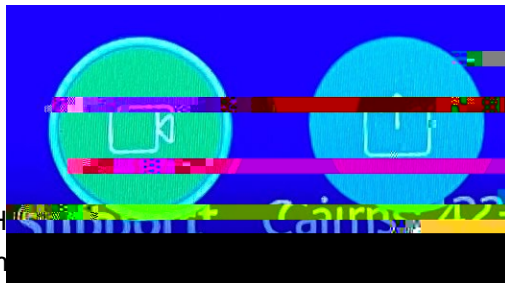
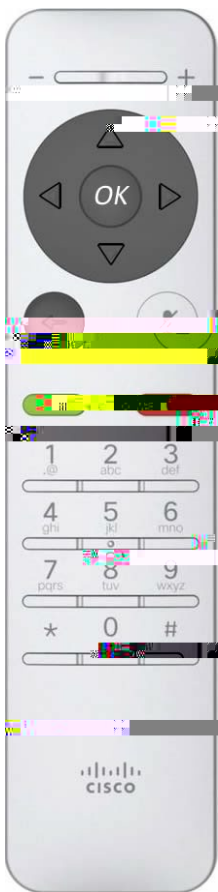


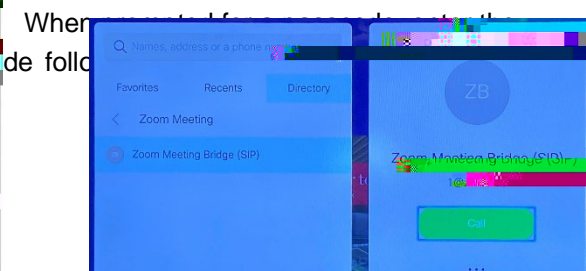
## Zoom connection guide

### General information

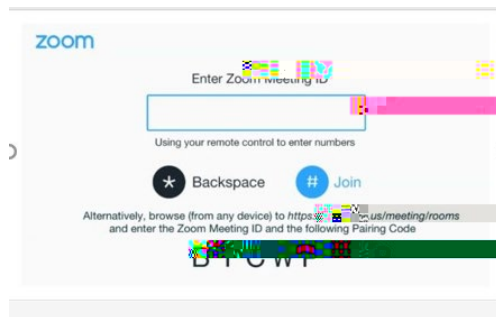
Video conferences and Zoom meetings are usually scheduled by VAVS to connect automatically provided [videoconferencing@jcu.edu.au](mailto:videoconferencing@jcu.edu.au) has been invited by the host prior to the meeting. To connect to the meeting, use the monitor with the Cisco remote and tap the OK key



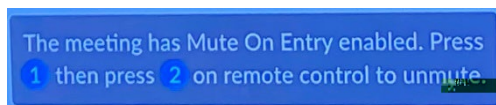
2. Hold the Zoom key followed by the # key



When the screen displays the Zoom Meeting Bridge (SIP) dial-in screen, follow the instructions on the screen.



6. If meeting has Mute On Entry enabled, press 1 then press 2 on remote to unmute



## Show presentation (share screen)

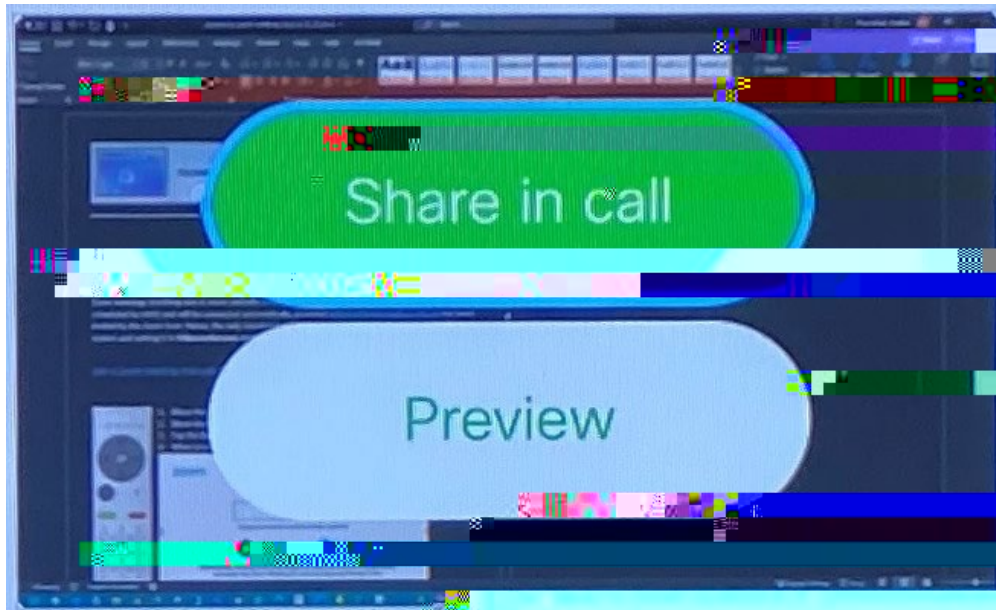
Presentations are shown from a laptop connected by the HDMI cable or wirelessly (Cisco Proximity).

### ¼ Show Laptop connected by HDMI cable

1. Connect the HDMI cable to the laptop
2. Enable the laptop's dual display (duplicate/mirror display)
3. Highlight the Share Screen button on the TV monitor and tap the OK key

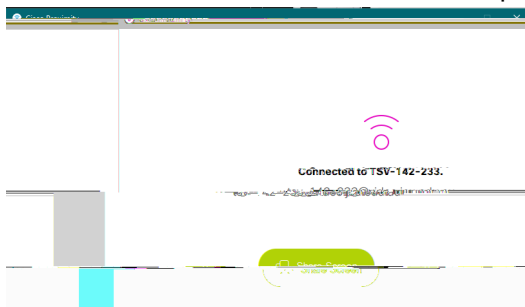


4. Highlight the Share in call button and tap the OK key to show PC in full screen mode



### ¼ Show laptop wirelessly

1. Run the Cisco Proximity app
2. Click on the Share Screen button on the pop-up window



3. The laptop screen is duplicated in full screen mode on the TV monitor
